

DEAR RESIDENTS,

Our Sharodotsav is going to celebrate its 17th year this time. In the last 16 years, you have been familiar with the coupon system of lunch distribution. This system, technically known as “MANUAL COUPON COLLECTION & LEDGER MARKING”, will be set aside this time.

To acquaint residents with the new system we are publishing this educational information leaflet.

1. This system will be known as AUTOMATED TOKEN CAPTURE SYSTEM
2. All residents above 5 years of age will be provided with an UNIQUE QUICK RESPONSE TOKEN
3. This UQRT shall remain the property of the committee at all times
4. Committee has decided to collect ₹1/- only as REFUNDABLE SECURITY DEPOSIT for them.
5. At ANY TIME or UPON REQUIREMENT OF THE COMMITTEE, if card is deposited IN USABLE CONDITION, security deposit will be refunded.
6. With regard to usability, the opinion of the technology consultant of the committee SHALL BE BINDING on all.
7. Committee reserves right to FORFEIT the deposit if the card is returned in unusable condition like being subjected to distortion, loss, partial or complete burning, etc... In urgent cases if a temporary UQRT has to be generated the holder must bear the expenses for the same, as directed by committee.
8. This card is for use by residents themselves only. It cannot be used by or transferred to another resident or guest. When the resident becomes unable to use the card, it must be surrendered immediately. Guests will be issued separate Single-use UQRT.
9. Residents, Committee members and Guests must sit with the card. The data on the card will be captured using ATCS. The card won't have to be surrendered unlike the COUPONS. You must retain the card safely for next use after 20 hours minimum.
10. Your card, unless deposited with the committee, must remain in your possession at all times. It entitles you to unique privileges. According to ATCS, no one but you can use your card.
11. If your card is used more than once in a gap of 20 hours, you will be liable to pay the amount of money as per existing plate rates of that day.
12. Cards of Residents, Committee Members and Guests have separate colour schemes, however it entitles them to no additional privileges.

The use of this new technology would immensely help reduce time and mistakes of MCCL marking system by enabling real time monitoring through online mode.
